- Minimise the risk of causing costly damage to expensive surfaces.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES



SURFACES

Recognise the five most common surface categories and finishes.

Summarise the dos and don'ts of caring for the different surfaces and finishes.

Identify types of damage that you can cause to surfaces if you do not care for them correctly.



DIRT, SOILING & STAINS

Recognise different types of dirt, soiling and stains, and explain how to remove them.

Recognise when you need to engage an expert to remove a stain or repair a damage.



CLEANING TOOLS

Choose the most suitable cleaning tool/s (cloth, sponge or mop head), for a given task.

Choose the most suitable type of vacuum cleaner and vacuum cleaner head for a given floorcleaning scenario.



CLEANING METHODS

Determine the most appropriate cleaning or mopping method to remove a given type of dirt or soiling from a given surface or floor type.

Summarize the dos and don'ts of vacuum cleaning and mopping.



CLEANING CHEMICALS

Choose the correct type of cleaning chemical for a given scenario.

Identify the safety precautions you must take when working with or storing cleaning chemicals.
