

## LAUNDRY WORKSHOP

- ✓ Identify potential risks and safety precautions to take when doing the laundry.
- ✓ Recognise types of damage that can be caused to expensive fabrics or garments in the laundry by incorrect care.
- ✓ Identify the properties and care requirements of different types of fabrics and embellishments.
- ✓ Identify and treat common types of dirt, soiling, and stains.
- ✓ Correctly wash and dry the items in your laundry basket, minimising the risk of damage.
- ✓ Neatly present and store clean and dry laundry items.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES



FABRICS, FIBRES & WEAVES

Recognise the different types of fabrics, fibres and weaves.

Outline the most appropriate type of care for a given fabric or garment.

Identify types of damage that can occur to garments in the laundry and ways to minimise the risk of damage occurring.



DIRT, STAINS & SOILING

Recognise and treat common types of dirt, stains and soiling.

Take precautions to minimise the risk of damage or colour transfer between items in the laundry.

Explain why it's important to properly sort, prepare, and correctly load your laundry into a washing machine or tumble dryer.



DETERGENT & AIDS

Choose the most suitable laundry detergent(s) for a given type of fabric and soiling.

Select the correct dose of laundry detergent for a given scenario.

Identify times when laundry aids such as fabric softeners, laundry boosters, laundry disinfectants, or starch can be useful. Outline the dos and don'ts of using each.



WASHING METHODS

Choose suitable programmes and machine settings to correctly wash and dry your laundry.

Clean and maintain your washing machine and tumble dryer, including filters.

Correctly handwash and air-dry delicate laundry items.



PRESENTATION

Correctly fold or hang your washed and dried laundry for storage.

Explain why it is important to rotate returned laundry items in storage.
